

**ENGLISH MAJOR WITH SECONDARY EDUCATION CONCENTRATION
OR MIDDLE SCHOOL CONCENTRATION**

Prerequisite: A grade of C or above in EN 101 and EN 102. (Effective 5/31/02 a grade of C+ or above in EN 101 and 102 will be necessary.) **Neither EN 101 nor EN 102 applies to the credits needed for the major. Requirements in English must total 36 credits. No more than 6 of these credits may be in 200-level literature courses.** This restriction does not apply to 200-level writing courses (including EN 203). Film courses do not count for literature or writing because they are listed in their own separate category.
