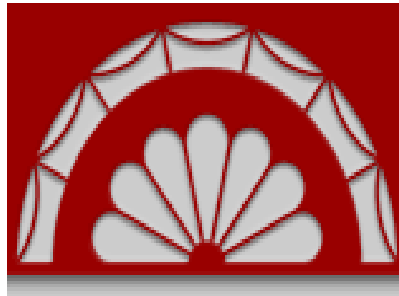


Predictable Books for Children
