Each McADOC Promotion Peer Educator will:

1. Attend Fall/Spring mandatory training programs. Training is an integral aspect of the McADOC Peer Educator position. In order to fulfill the responsibilities of the position and develop a strong team spirit, a thorough training is necessary.
2. Serve as a positive peer educator for other students on campus by teaching/promoting the goal of reducing alcohol and other drug use/abuse and promoting health/wellness at Bridgewater State College.
3. Present alcohol and other drug education programs to campus groups. Participate in sponsored events such as conferences, guest speakers, etc.
4. Actively participate in all scheduled McADOC Peer Educator team meetings during the semester. The McADOC Peer Educators meet Tuesdays, 3pm-5pm.
5. Complete weekly office hour.
6. Develop and implement specialized alcohol/drug education and related health campaigns.
7. Promote McADOC on campus by being involved and demonstrating enthusiasm and pride in the program.
