



Bridgewater State College Transit is excited to announce a new and improved transit shuttle service for the fall that is sure to provide improved safety, reliability and greater customer satisfaction.

Our routes have changed to better service the greater needs of the campus community and to provide a shuttle service that is more energy efficient. The new buses are smaller in size at 31ft long, can accommodate up to 24 passengers, and are handicap accessible. The buses are more fuel efficient, allow for the use of biodiesel, and are equipped with energy-efficient equipment. Bike racks will also be included on the new buses, so bring your bike and hop on board!

#### **Important Changes to the Shuttle Service:**

1. **Elimination of Park Avenue for the Fixed Route Service :** Eliminating stops along Park Avenue such as Auditorium, Kelly Gym, and Stearns Garden, will provide for a more efficient and reliable service. Park Avenue is a heavily travelled road, not only by vehicles but pedestrian traffic as well; this creates delays for the service and creates dangerous situations, both for the bus driver and for faculty, students, and staff.
2. **Rt.28 Bridgewater/Brockton Service Changes:** the Brockton bus will now originate from Harrington Hall with a stop at Tillinghast before heading to Brockton's South Plaza (formerly Shaw's) via Route 28.

During the fall semester, we will monitor the service to see if additional improvements are required and make changes, if necessary, before the spring semester begins.
