



### **SPECIAL NOTE TO STUDENTS**

- Students should consult their Infobear degree audit to see which catalog they have been assigned. Look for “Catalog Term” reference on the degree audit.
- In order to explore requirements for another catalog, use the “What-If Analysis” button.
- All students must follow the requirements listed in a single catalog. Students may not use the major requirements from one catalog and the General Education or Core Curriculum requirements from another.
- Students must complete the degree requirements for a bachelor’s degree under a catalog in effect within eight year of the date of graduation. The catalog used, however, may be no earlier than the catalog in effect at the time of matriculation.

#### **Students following a pre-2006 catalog:**

- Students who were attending BSC prior to 2006 but would like to complete the Core Curriculum may do so by filling out a Request to [Change Catalog Year form](#) and selecting a new catalog. However, these students must also follow the major, concentration and minor requirements for the same catalog.
- Continuing students may also continue to follow the GER. However, because students must complete all of their requirements for a bachelor’s degree under a catalog in effect within eight (8) years of their date of graduation, continuing students who wish to continue to follow the GER must graduate by August 2014.

#### **Returning Students:**

- Students who were enrolled at BSC prior to fall of 2006, stopped attending and are now re-enrolled should consult their degree audit to see which catalog they have been assigned. These students may choose to follow a different catalog by filling out the [Request to Change Catalog Year Form](#).

#### **New Students:**

- Students who enrolled at BSC for the first time in the fall of 2006 or later (i.e., first year students or transfer students) **MUST** follow the new Core Curriculum.
