

Edward Donovan Scholarship

Thanks to the generosity of the staff of the Old Colony Elderly Services, the family and friends of Edward Donovan, and the broader southeastern social work community, the leadership of the BSC Social Work Department is able to award the Edward Donovan Scholarship in Social Work. This generous scholarship, first awarded in 2008, will be given to a student who meets the criteria stated below, selected by a committee comprised of BSC social work faculty.

Criteria:

- Social work major
- Junior or Senior standing
- Minimum overall GPA of 3.0
- Documented financial need
- Preference given to students from Plymouth County, Stoughton, Easton or Avon, Massachusetts and for those with a demonstrated interest in working in the aging field or with the elderly

Award:

- \$1,150

Application:

- Applicants must submit a 250 word (maximum) statement of your primary social work interest and career plans, and
- a brief statement of support from either a supervisor or a member of the social work faculty who can attest to your performance in the social work program.

Process:

- Application materials must be emailed, as attached documents, to June Metcalf (jmetcalf@bridgew.edu)
- Complete materials are due by 4 p.m. February 25, 2009
- Financial need will be confirmed by the Office of Financial Aid
- Applications will be reviewed by a committee comprised of Social Work faculty. The recipient will be selected by the committee and notified when the decision has been made.
