**HealthReach Community Health Centers** seeks an independently **licensed clinical social worker** to join the medical teams at two practices. Working four days per week (total) in Madison and Kingfield, the LCSW will offer consultation services to patients and primary care providers concerning behavioral changes that impact patient health status. The interventions will be brief, time-limited and solution-focused.

The LCSW will also assist with case management and serve as a liaison with community resources. The selected candidate will receive competitive compensation, malpractice coverage, and may be eligible for loan repayment. Madison Area and Mt. Abram Regional Health Centers are two of the eleven practices of HealthReach Community Health Centers, which provide primary care to 30,000 patients in Central and Western Maine each year. EOE.

### Practice Profile:

At **Madison Area Health Center**, physicians, Burton Knapp and Nancy Knapp as well as family nurse practitioners, Stephen Dickey and Linda Tully provide medical care to 1,700 area residents from Madison and neighboring towns including Anson, Norridgewock, and Starks. At **Mt. Abram Regional Health Center**, family nurse practitioner, Sharon Doughty and physician assistant, Neil Robertson serve 1,500 residents and travelers from Carrabasset Valley, Coplin and Dallas Plantations, Eustis, Kingfield, New Portland, and Stratton, as well as other locations in and outside of Maine. At both outpatient locations, patients represent the full scope of family practice with the exception of obstetrical care.

Our providers emphasize prevention of illness, maintenance of good health, and health education. Health center services include care of chronic and acute illnesses, physicals, laboratory services and community resource referrals. We accept commercial insurance, MaineCare (Medicaid) and Medicare. In addition, through an ongoing grant from the federal Bureau of Primary Health Care, we offer Affordable Care services to patients who meet income guidelines and assist with applications for prescription assistance programs and linkage to community services.

HealthReach Community Health Centers is a private, non-profit organization that has been providing health care in rural and medically underserved areas of Central and Western Maine for thirty-seven years. Annually, 30,000 Maine residents and visitors access services through our

eleven community health centers. HealthReach provides a medical director, on-site practice manager, modern office set-up, support staff, centralized billing and electronic medical records.

**Community Profiles:**
