

Update from the BSU College of Education and Health Sciences Regarding MTEL

11/10/20

The MA Department of Elementary and Secondary Education has provided this update regarding on-line and in-person MTEL administration during COVID-19:

- The following MTELs were made available for on-line administration in October 2020: Phase 1
 - Communication and Literacy Skills (Reading and Writing)
 - Foundations of Reading
 - Sheltered English Immersion
 - English as a Second Language
 - English
- The following additional MTELs were made available for on-line administration in November 2020: Phase 2
 - History
 - Physical Education
 - Reading Specialist
 - Visual Art
 - Health/Family and Consumer Sciences

- On-line administration will be offered during a one-week window every month.
- There are currently no capacity limits for on-line MTEL administration slots.
- The availability for on-line test administration has freed up many seats for in-person testing at the Pearson testing centers.
- The Pearson testing centers have expanded their operating hours for in-person testing.
- Candidates should check test availability often if they are concerned about timing as testing slots continue to open up.
