Route 28 operates from B.S.U. to South Plaza - Brockton along route 28. Passengers wishing to board the bus may do so by standing in a clear, safe area and waving to the bus as it approaches. To get off in a particular area press the chime bar when you would like to exit the bus. The bus driver will stop at the next safe area. It is up to the driver to decide if an area is safe or not. Please do not stand near busy intersections or in any unsafe location. **Rt. 28 connects with BAT Rt's 2 service to Downtown Brockton.**
